GEL Putter

The Rego model of the Paul Hurrion range of GEL putters is a perfect example of just how far this new company has come in a very short time. We first covered the GEL (Groove Equipment Ltd.) lineup about this time last year. Leading to a strong presence at the 2008 PGA Merchandise Show, however, the buzz on the company's latest products became all the more



audible. Last summer, the company signed on Hurrion, a golf guru and putting coach of British Open champion Padraig Harrington, to design an exclusive line of putters for GEL. To say the putters were anything less than an absolute hit would be an understatement. MWG staffers sampled several of the new short blades, but the Rego proved to be the bona fide favorite. It's a beautiful face-balanced blade with modified alignment, inline weighting, perimeter weighting and a center shaft (no offset). Weight alignment arms create unique weight distribution within the putter face. A three-line alignment setup squares up the face to help you zero in on the cup. The putter sports a beautiful black nickel finish and comes in lengths from 32 to 35 inches.
